”



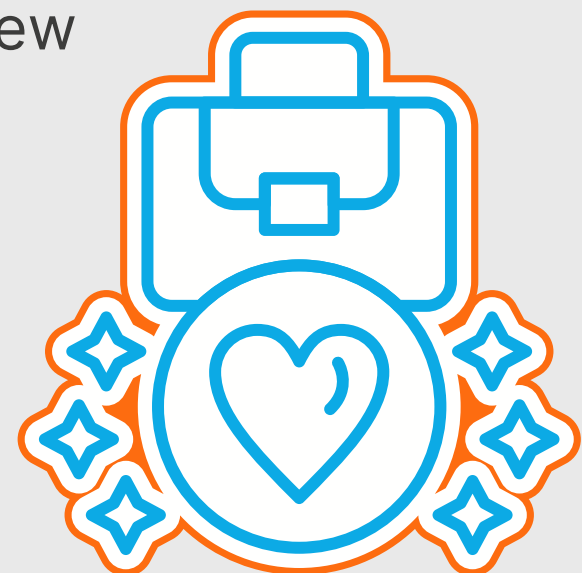
